Information clause of DWUP - Intermediate Body for European Funds for Lower Silesia 2021-2027:

In order to comply with the obligation imposed by Articles 13 and 14 of RODO, in connection with Article 88 of the Law on the Principles of Implementation of Tasks Financed from European Funds in the Financial Perspective 2021-2027, we inform you about the principles of processing your personal data:

I. Administrator

A separate controller of your data is:

1. Director of the Lower Silesian Regional Labor Office, 5B Ogrodowa Street, 58-306 Walbrzych.

II. Purpose of data processing

Personal data will be processed in connection with the implementation of FEDS 2021-2027, in particular for the purposes of monitoring, reporting, communication, publication, evaluation, financial management, verification and audits, and for determining the eligibility of participants.

Provision of data is voluntary, but necessary for the above-mentioned purpose.

Refusal to provide them is equivalent to the impossibility of taking appropriate action.

III. Basis for processing

Your personal data will be processed in connection with:

1. The processing is necessary for the fulfillment of the controller's legal obligation (Article 6(1)(c) and, in the case of special category data, Article 9(2)(g) RODO), which specifies:
 - Regulation (EU) No. 2021/1060 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 June 2021 laying down common provisions on the European Regional Development Fund, the European Social Fund Plus, the Cohesion Fund, the Fair Transition Fund and the European Maritime, Fisheries and Aquaculture Fund and the financial rules for these Funds and for the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund, the Internal Security Fund and the Financial Support Facility for Border Management and Visa Policy,
 - Regulation (EU) 2021/1057 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 June 2021 establishing the European Social Fund Plus (ESF+) and repealing Regulation (EU) No. 1296/2013 (Official Journal of the EU L 231, 30.06.2021, p. 21, as amended).
 - Law of April 28, 2022 on the principles of implementation of tasks financed from European funds in the financial perspective 2021-2027, in particular Articles 87-93,
 - Law of June 14, 1960. - Administrative Procedure Code,
 - Law of August 27, 2009 on public finance.



2. Processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party, or to take action at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract (Article 6(1)(b) RODO).
3. Processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of public authority vested in the controller (Article 6(1)(e) of the DPA).

IV. Scope of data processed.

The scope of the data we may process is defined in Article 87(2) of the Implementation Act.

V. Method of data acquisition

We obtain the data directly from the data subjects, from the ICT system, or from the public registers referred to in Article 92(2) of the Implementation Act.

VI. Access to personal data

Your personal data can be accessed by employees and associates of the administrator. In addition, your personal data may be entrusted to or shared with:

1. entities we have contracted to perform tasks in FEDS 2021-2027,
2. bodies of the European Commission, the minister in charge of regional development, the minister in charge of public finance, the president of the social security institution,
3. entities that perform services for us related to the operation and development of ICT systems, as well as the provision of connectivity, such as IT solution providers and telecommunications operators.

VII. Data retention period

Personal data is retained for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes specified in Section II.

VIII. Rights of data subjects

You are entitled to the following rights:

1. The right to access your data and to receive a copy of it (Article 15 RODO),
2. The right to rectify your data (Article 16 of the RODO),
3. The right to erasure of your data (Article 17 RODO) - if the circumstances referred to in Article 17(3) RODO have not occurred,
4. The right to request the controller to restrict the processing of your data (Article 18 RODO),
5. The right to object to the processing of his/her data (Article 21 RODO) - to the processing of personal data concerning him/her based on Article 6(1)(e) RODO - if the circumstances referred to in Article 21(1) RODO have not occurred,
6. The right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority of the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (Article 77 of the RODO) - in case a person considers that the processing of his/her personal data violates the provisions of the RODO or other national regulations governing the protection of personal data applicable in Poland.



IX. Automated decision-making

Personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.

X. Transfer of data to a third country

Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country.
